- Access by car
After exiting the Beppu Inter change on Higashi Kyushu Expressway, take the route 11 towards Yufuin for about 5 minutes.
- Access by local bus from JR Beppu station.
JR Beppu station (West exit) About 20minutes by Kamenoi bus.
JR Beppu station (East exit) [Kamenoi bus] About 40 minutes by "Yufurin" Express bus via Kannawa.
JR Yufuin station bus center About 30minutes by Kamenoi bus.

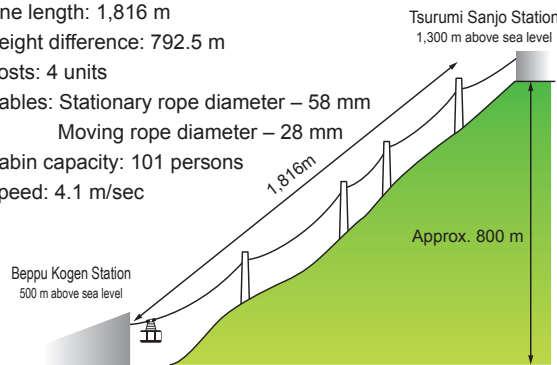

Ropeway Overview (Opened on December 21, 1962)

- ◎ 4-cable regular aerial tramway (2 stationary ropes, 2 moving ropes)
- ◎ Line length: 1,816 m
- ◎ Height difference: 792.5 m
- ◎ Posts: 4 units
- ◎ Cables: Stationary rope diameter – 58 mm
Moving rope diameter – 28 mm
- ◎ Cabin capacity: 101 persons
- ◎ Speed: 4.1 m/sec

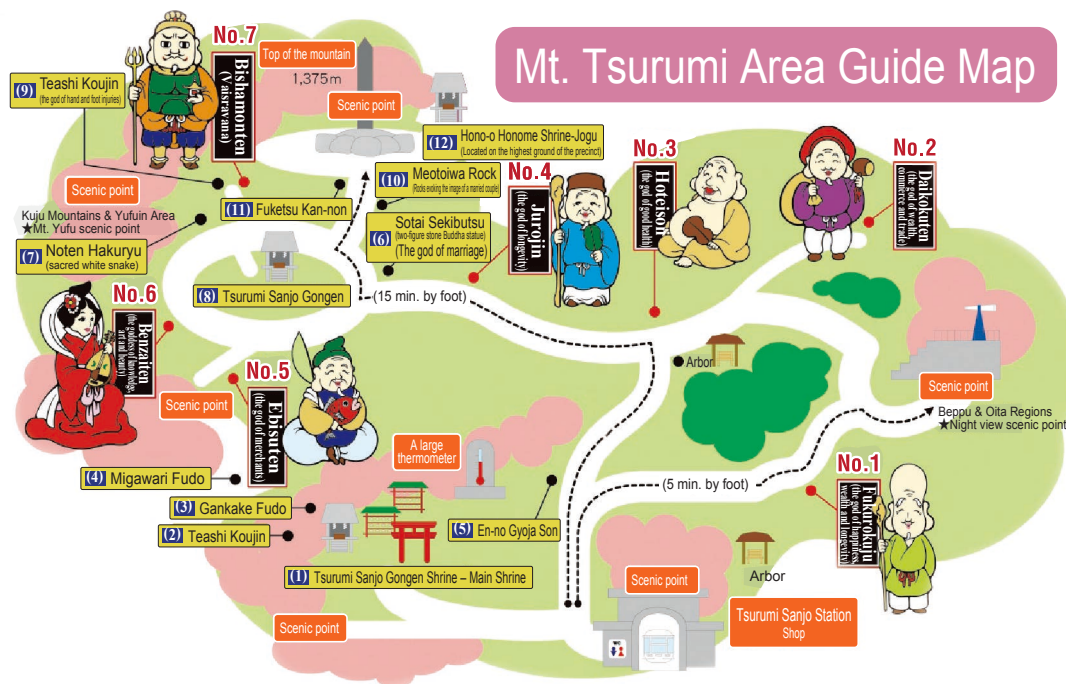
Aso-Kuju National Park **Mt. Tsurumi**

The panoramic view from Mt. Tsurumi and seasonal beauty

Standing 1,375m high, Mt. Tsurumi is located at the east edge of Aso-Kuju National Park.

Mt. Tsurumi is an active volcano with fumarole activity still occurring in the backside, and is the source of Beppu Hot Spring. The top of Mt. Tsurumi offers a beautiful view of the Beppu Area, Mt. Yufu, the Kuju Mountains, and the Chugoku and Shikoku Regions.

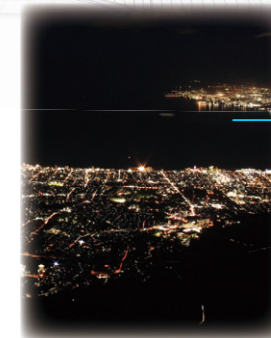
Beppu has plenty of seasonal delights for everyone - rhododendrons and cherry blossoms in spring, cool temperatures in summer, beautiful autumn leaves, and hoarfrost in winter.

Mid-May to Early June



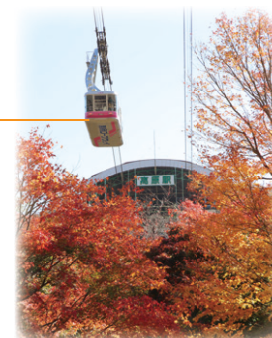

Early December to Mid-March
- New Year's Day:
Traditional first shrine visit of the year, or prayer at the first sunrise of the year
